Agenda: The agenda for this meeting was posted on the State electronic calendar as required by HRS section 92-7(b).

A short video was played to explain procedures for this virtual meeting and how members of the public can participate and interact with the Board during the meeting.

Chairperson Leong proceeded with roll call. All Board members were present.

Call to Order: There being a quorum present, Chairperson Leong called the meeting to order at 9:08 a.m.

Minutes: It was moved by Mr. Isemoto, seconded by Mr. Teves, and unanimously carried to approve the Applications Committee Meeting Minutes of May 10, 2021 and the Board Meeting and Executive Session Meeting Minutes of April 23, 2021, as circulated.

Chapter 91, HRS,
Adjudicatory
Matters:

Chairperson Leong called for a recess from the Board's meeting at 9:10 a.m. to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91.

1. Settlement Agreements

a. In the Matter of the Contractor's License of Mailefihi Niutupuivaha, doing business as MTN Builders; CLB 2020-221-L

RICO received a complaint alleging that Mailefihi Niutupuivaha, doing business as MTN Builders("Respondent") defaulted on the purchase of a property sale and had started construction on the property before obtaining a building permit.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statute: HRS section 444-17(16) (willful violation of a county law relating to building).

Respondent agrees to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$1,000.00.

b. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of Young's Pacific Builders, LLC and Young Dal Kim; CLB 2019-229-L

RICO received a complaint against Young's Pacific Builders, LLC and Young Dal Kim ("Respondents") from the homeowners of a residence renovated by Respondents (the "Project").

The Homeowners and Respondents have reached a private settlement of claims.

RICO alleges that the contract for the Project failed to contain all required homeowner disclosures.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statute and rules: HRS section 444-25.5 (information required in homeowner contracts), HAR sections 16-77-71 (RME responsible for violations by contracting entity), and 16-77-80 (disclosures required in homeowner contracts).

Respondents agree to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$2,500.00.

- c. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of Ronald L. Taylor and Terra Nova Industries; CLB 2017-200-L

RICO received a complaint alleging that Ronald L. Taylor ("Respondent Taylor") was not in residence in the State of Hawaii from April of 2017 to July of 2017, during which time Terra Nova Industries ("Respondent Terra Nova") was working on a project to construct The Lucky Strike Bowling Alley at the Ala Moana Shopping Center in Honolulu, Hawaii.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following rules: HAR section 16-77-71(a)(4) (RME shall be in residence in Hawaii during the period the project is under construction) and 16-77-71(a)(5) (RME shall be held responsible for any violation of HAR).

Respondents agree to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$20,000.00.

It was noted that the contractor's license number for Respondent Terra Nova in paragraph A3 should be BC 18853.

- d. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of JC Contracting, LLC and Fortunato V. Corpuz, Jr.; CLB 2020-104-L

RICO received a complaint alleging that JC Contracting, LLC and Fortunato V. Corpuz, Jr. ("Respondents") exhibited poor workmanship in the renovation of an existing residence (the "Project").

Respondents alleged that they were removed from the Project, but are willing to return to the Project to perform any required fixes.

RICO alleges that the contract for the Project failed to contain all required homeowner disclosures.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statute and rule: HRS section 444-25.5 (information required in homeowner contracts), HAR sections 16-77-71 (RME responsible for violations by contracting entity) and 16-77-80 (disclosures required in homeowner contracts).

Respondents agree to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$2,500.00.

- e. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of AGT Construction, LLC and Alex Greg Talboys; CLB 2020-191-L

RICO alleges that AGT Construction, LLC and Alex Greg Talboys ("Respondents") subcontracted with an unlicensed contractor to perform work at a condominium in Honolulu, Hawaii.

Respondents allege that they used the subcontractor previously and were not aware that the subcontractor was no longer licensed, and the subcontractor provided an additional insured certificate.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statute and rules: HRS section 444-17(17) (entering into a contract with an unlicensed contractor involving work requiring a HRS chapter 444 license), and HAR sections 16-77-71 and 16-77-75 (RME responsible for acts and omissions of contracting entity).

Respondents agree to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$5,000.00.

After discussion it was moved by Mr. Isemoto, seconded by Mr. Teves, and unanimously carried, to approve the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action in the above cases.

Following the Board's review, deliberation and decisions in these matters, pursuant to HRS chapter 91, Chairperson Leong announced that the Board was reconvening to its open meeting at 9:36 a.m.

Roger Lebouf stated that he received a deferral letter from the Board and asked if his requested documents were received. Executive Officer informed Mr. Lebouf that the Board does not have his application file at this meeting and staff will respond to his inquiry when they are in the office and have access to his application file.

Jeffrey C. Morgan, RME, Culp Construction Company stated that he wanted to discuss his application. Executive Officer Ito informed Mr. Morgan that the Board will call him into the Executive Session meeting to discuss his application.

Session:

At 9:53 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Isemoto, seconded by Mr. Arita, and unanimously carried, to enter into executive session pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(1) to consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for professional or vocational licenses cited in HRS section 26-9, and to consult with Christopher Leong, Deputy Attorney General, on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(4).

Mr. O'Donnell left the meeting at 10:24 a.m.

Mr. O'Donnell returned to the meeting at 11:10 a.m.

At 1:03 p.m., it was moved by Mr. Isemoto, seconded by Mr. Teves, and unanimously carried, to move out of executive session and to reconvene to the Board's regular order of business.
