Agenda: The agenda for this meeting was posted on the State electronic calendar as required by HRS section 92-7(b).

A short video was played to explain procedures for this virtual meeting and how members of the public can participate and interact with the Board during the meeting.

Vice Chairperson Leong proceeded with roll call. All Board members were present.

Call to Order: There being a quorum present, Vice Chairperson Leong called the meeting to order at 9:08 a.m.

Minutes: It was moved by Mr. Teves, seconded by Mr. Isemoto, and unanimously carried

to approve the Applications Committee Meeting Minutes of June 29, 2020 and July 20, 2020, and the Board Meeting and Executive Session Meeting Minutes of March 13, 2020 and Board Meeting Minutes of June 19, 2020, as circulated.

Chapter 91, HRS,
Adjudicatory
Matters:

Vice Chairperson Leong called for a recess from the Board's meeting at 9:12 a.m. to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91.

1. Settlement Agreements

a. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of AAA Roofing and General Contractors, Inc., formerly doing business as AAA Roofing Company, Inc.; James F. Boulton; CLB 2014-67-L

RICO alleges that AAA Roofing and General Contractors, Inc.*, formerly doing business as AAA Roofing Company, Inc. and James F. Boulton's ("Respondents") contract for the removal and replacement of a roof for a homeowner was missing required homeowner disclosures.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statute and rule: HRS section 444.25.5(b)** (required homeowners disclosure in written contract) and HAR section 16-77-80 (required homeowner disclosures in contracts).

Respondents agree to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$1,500.00.

Note: *Respondent's name should be AAA Roofing Company and General Contractors, Inc; and F

** Citation should be HRS section 444-25.5(b)

b. In the Matter of the Contractor's License of BKP Construction LLC; CLB 2019-535-L

On or about May 24, 2018, Bryon Pojas ("Pojas"), a member of BKP Construction LLC ("BKP" or "Respondent") entered into a contract with a homeowner for a home extension for compensation on behalf of BKP.

At the time Pojas entered into the contract on behalf of BKP, Pojas was not a licensed contractor.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statute: HRS section 444-17(8) (when the licensee being a partnership or a joint venture permits any partner, member, or employee of partnership or joint venture who does not hold a license to have the direct management of the contracting business thereof).

Respondent agrees to the voluntary surrender of Respondent's license.

c. In the Matter of the Contractor's License of Patrick O. Spaulding; CLB 2019-536-L

On or about May 24, 2018, Bryon Pojas, a member of BKP, entered into a contract with a homeowner for a home extension for compensation on behalf of BKP, without the knowledge of Patrick O. Spaulding ("Respondent"), who is the RME for BKP. At the time Pojas entered into the contract on behalf of BKP, Pojas was not a licensed contractor.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute the violations of the following statute and rules: HRS section 436B-19(17) (violating licensing law or rules), HAR sections 16-77-70(b) (The contracting business of a contracting entity shall be under the direct management of a principal RME), 16-77-71(a)(1) (RME responsible for compliance) and 16-77-71(a)(2) (RME to be familiar with all contracts the contracting entity enters into).

Respondent agrees to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$1,000.00

- d. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of Aquatic Solutions Hawaii, LLC; Steven R. Maratta; CLB 2018-149-L and CLB 2019-37-L

RICO received a complaint concerning Aquatic Solutions Hawaii, LLC and Steven R. Maratta ("Respondents") work at a homeowner's residence. Based on the complaint concerning the work RICO opened Case No. CLB 2018-149-L.

RICO received another complaint concerning Respondents' work at another homeowner's residence. Based on the complaint concerning the work RICO opened Case No. CLB 2019-37-L.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute the violations of the following statutes and rule: HRS sections 444-17(12) (failure to comply with the rules), 444-25.5 (disclosures required in written contracts), and HAR section 16-77-80 (homeowner contracts).

Respondents agree to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$3,000.00.

- e. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of Abhe and Svoboda, Inc., and Gail Svoboda; CLB 2017-365-L and CLB 2019-390-L

On or about October 19, 2016, the State of Hawaii, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations ("DLIR") issued ABHE & Svoboda, Inc. ("ABHE") a Notification of Violation ("NOV") based upon work performed by ABHE for a project.

The October 19, 2016 NOV alleged that ABHE failed to pay overtime wages and submitted incorrect certified payrolls.

The October 19, 2016 NOV requested that ABHE pay \$1,229.91 in wages and a penalty of \$ 200.00 which were fully paid without any express admission of liability of ABHE.

Based on the October 19, 2016 NOV, RICO opened Case No. CLB 2017-365-L, which was closed with a warning letter dated December 31, 2018.

On or about July 5, 2018, the State of Hawaii, DLIR issued ABHE a second NOV

based upon work performed by ABHE on a project.

The July 5, 2018 NOV alleged that ABHE failed to pay correct overtime wages and submitted incorrect and incomplete certified payrolls.

The July 5, 2018 NOV requested that ABHE to pay \$2,249.35 in wages and a penalty of \$2,249.35 which were fully paid without any express admission of liability by ABHE.

ABHE and Gail Svoboda ("Respondents") did not report the October 19, 2016 or July 5, 2018 NOV's to the Board within thirty (30) days.

Based upon the July 5, 2018 NOV, RICO re-opened Case CLB 2017-365-L and opened Case No. CLB 2019-390-L.

On January 14, 2020, ABHE received signed copies of Settlement Agreements and Stipulated Final Orders related to two matters brought before the Worker's Compensation Board for the State of Oregon by way of citations which ABHE had appealed ("Oregon Settlement Agreements").

The Oregon Settlement Agreements were both approved and signed on behalf of the Workers' Compensation Board, State of Oregon on December 16, 2019.

The Oregon Settlement Agreements were both expressly entered as "informal dispositions of a contested case made by stipulation, agreed settlement or a consent order" into pursuant to Oregon State (ORS 654.078(7)) which mandates that such settlement or order "shall not be pleaded or admissible in evidence as an admission or confession in any criminal prosecution or any civil proceeding that may be instituted against the employer except in the case of a civil proceeding brought to enforce the stipulation, settlement, or order."

ABHE represents and warrants that it has fully satisfied and is in full compliance with all provisions of the Oregon Settlement Agreements.

Because ABHE entered into the Oregon Settlement Agreements without any admission of liability and because they were entered as "informal dispositions" subject to any exculpatory provisions and evidentiary restrictions in the Oregon Settlement Agreements as cited above, ABHE and its management had no clear understanding of whether it was required to report the Settlement Agreements under HRS section 436B.

Out of an abundance of caution and in the interest of full transparency, ABHE voluntarily provided copies of the Oregon Settlements to RICO.

The parties agree that any allegations concerning the Oregon Settlement Agreements would be recognized and dealt with as part of this Settlement Agreement.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute the violations of the following statutes: HRS section 436B-19(15) (Failure to report in writing to the licensing authority any disciplinary decision issued against the licensee or the applicant in another jurisdiction within 30 days of the disciplinary

action) and 444-17(6) (Willful violation of any law of the State, or any county, relating to building, including any violation of any applicable rule of the department of health, or of any applicable safety or labor law).

Respondents agree to pay an administrative fine the amount of \$1,000.00.

- f. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of Hawaii Design & Development, LLC; Matthew S. Azouz; CLB 2019-17-L

RICO alleges that Hawaii Design & Development, LLC and Matthew S. Azouz ("Respondents") contract for renovation of a residence located in Kailua, Hawaii was missing required homeowner disclosures.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute the violations of the following statute and rule: HRS section 444.25.5(b)* (required homeowners disclosure in written contract and HAR 16-77-80 (required homeowner disclosures in contracts).

Respondents agree to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$2,500.00.

Note: *Citation should be HRS section 444-25.5(b)

- g. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of Pool Pro, Inc; Derek G. Smith; CLB 2019-477-L

RICO alleges that Pool Pro, Inc. and Derek G. Smith's ("Respondents") contract for the construction of an in-ground swimming pool, at a residence located in Kihei, Hawaii, was missing required homeowner disclosures.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute the violations of the following statute and rule: HRS section 444.25.5(b)* (required homeowners disclosure in written contract and HAR 16-77-80 (required homeowner disclosures in contracts).

Respondents agree to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$2,500.00.

Note: *Citation should be HRS section 444-25.5(b)

- h. In the Matter of the Contractor's License of Andrew R. Brodzinski; CLB 2019-276-L

RICO alleges that Andrew R. Brodzinski's ("Respondent") contract for the renovation of a residence was missing required homeowner disclosures.

If proven at administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute the violations of the following statute and rule: HRS section 444.25.5(b)* (required homeowners disclosure in written contract) and HAR 16-77-80 (required homeowner disclosures in contracts).

Respondent agrees to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$2,500.00.

Note: *Citation should be HRS section 444-25.5(b)

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Isemoto, seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, and unanimously carried to approve the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action in the above cases.

Following the Board's review, deliberation and decisions in these matters, pursuant to HRS chapter 91, Vice Chairperson announced that the Board was reconvening to its open meeting at 9:40 a.m.

The "Amount of Supervisory Experience" should only include the actual amount of time spent on-site supervising his own crew. Do not include time spent for design, ordering materials, scheduling or downtime for rain-outs or waiting for delivery of materials.
