Agenda: The agenda for this meeting was posted on the State electronic calendar as required by HRS section 92-7(b).

A short video was played to explain procedures for this virtual meeting and how members of the public can participate and interact with the Board during the meeting.

Call to Order: There being a quorum present, Chairperson Isemoto called the meeting to order at 9:07 a.m. He welcomed new Board member, Jerry Nishek. Mr. Nishek is the RME for Kauai Nursery & Landscaping, Inc. and has been a licensed contractor for more than 25 years.

Amendments to the Agenda:

It was moved by Mr. Leong, seconded by Mr. Arita, and unanimously carried to approve the following amendment to the agenda:

Move Pacific Industrial Coatings LLC/Robert B. Johnson, RME from “Defer Applications; for further investigation or request for additional documentation” on the Applications Committee Recommendations list to Applications Committee Report under agenda item c.

Minutes: It was moved by Mr. Leong, seconded by Mr. Arita, and unanimously carried to approve the Applications Committee Meeting Minutes of August 2, 2021, with the following amendment:

“Christopher Leong, Deputy Attorney General, was excused from the meeting.”

It was moved by Mr. Leong, seconded by Mr. Arita, and unanimously carried to approve the Board Meeting and Executive Session Meeting Minutes of July 23, 2021, as circulated.

Committee Reports:

1. Scope of Activity Committee:
Leslie Isemoto, Chairperson

a. Core Utility LLC

Requests a determination whether installing underground duct lines, handholes and/or conductors from utility poles, transformers, or other handholes within the utility area (roadway/sidewalk) and/or to a residence’s meter location, is covered under the scope of a C-62 Pole and line contractor.

Mr. Dustin Partika, RME for Core Utility LLC was present. Core Utility LLC and Mr. Partika are currently licensed in the C-62 Pole and line and C-63 High voltage electrical classifications. Mr. Partika stated that he runs a pole and line crew doing work for the utility. He received a complaint alleging that he is working outside of his scope of work because he is performing electrical work under 600 volts and does not hold a C-13 electrical contractor’s license. Mr. Partika added that all of his work is done for the utility in the pole and line section. It’s the same work that he’s performed from the time he was an apprentice up to being a lineman with the utility. He is seeking clarification on the work that he is able to

perform.

Mr. Higashihara stated that the Board discussed a similar inquiry pertaining to traffic signal lighting from the Department of Education, East Kapolei Middle School phase 2 project. Executive Officer Ito stated that the East Kapolei Middle School inquiry was discussed at the September 20, 2019 meeting and those meeting minutes were distributed to the members. Chairperson Isemoto stated that he recalls that inquiry pertained to whether the C-13 Electrical contractor may perform traffic signal lighting work.

Executive
Session:

At 9:15 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Arita, and unanimously carried, to enter into executive session to consult with Christopher Leong, Deputy Attorney General, on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(4).

At 9:25 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Arita, seconded by Mr. Teves, and unanimously carried, to move out of executive session and to reconvene to the Board's regular order of business.

Chairperson Isemoto stated that the Board consulted with DAG Leong and reviewed the description of the C-62 Pole and line classification. The Scope Committee recommends responding that installing underground duct lines, handholes and/or conductors from utility poles, transformers, or other handholes within the utility area (roadway/sidewalk) and/or to a residence's meter location, is not covered under the scope of a C-62 Pole and line contractor; this work requires a C-13 contractor license. Chairperson Isemoto added that the C-62 contractor is permitted to perform work (including underground work) that may be under 600 volts, provided it is specifically in connection with street and highway lighting and traffic signal systems.

Mr. Partika stated that he is pulling high voltage conductors through the handholes and splices the conductors. He asked if the Board is saying that he cannot do the same for conductors that are under 600 volts when it goes through the same handhole. Chairperson Isemoto stated he would need the C-13 and the C-62 licenses to pull both conductors above and below 600 volts and splice them. Mr. Partika stated that it didn't make sense that he could not pull conductors with less than 600 volts because it's coming from the same source. Chairperson Isemoto stated that the C-62 is a specialty license for high voltage work; performing underground work with less than 600 volts that is not in connection with street and highway lighting and traffic signal systems is out of the scope of the C-62 contractor. Mr. Partika stated that it is in connection with the pole. The utility hired him to change out a pole and he installed a pole mounted transformer; the scope of the C-62 classification specifically states that he can perform this work. The low voltage side of the transformer is under 600 volts and it will go to the residence or to a handhole. He does not see why he cannot perform that work. He sees the C-13 work as being inside a building or house. If the utility sent out their own crew to do this work, they will send a pole and line crew and not the electricians. Chairperson Isemoto stated that doing the distribution under 600 volts for any work that is not associated with street and

highway lighting and traffic signal systems is in the scope of the C-13 contractor. Executive Officer Ito asked for clarification on Mr. Partika's example of the utility sending out its pole and line crew to perform the work. Mr. Partika stated that the utility does not send out electricians with the pole and line crew. Executive Officer Ito stated that it appears that public utility company employees are exempt from licensure. If a utility company contracts the work out, the exemption may not apply.

Mr. Partika asked how he would be able to obtain a C-13 license when he does not have an electrician apprenticeship. Chairperson Isemoto stated that he could employ a C-13 RME under his company to perform the C-13 work. Mr. Partika asked what the limit for a C-13 contractor is because he gets a lot of work from C-13 contractors that don't want to dig around high voltage electrical lines or enter the handholes that contain high voltage lines. Mr. Teves stated that there are C-13 contractors that are comfortable working next to high voltage lines. He clarified that it is incorrect to say that C-13 contractors don't perform that kind of work.

Executive Officer Ito clarified that if Mr. Partika applies for a C-13 license, he will be required to verify his on-site supervisory experience in the broad scope of the C-13 classification. He would need to take on other types of jobs to get a C-13 license. Mr. Partika stated that the work he performs is pulling cables and conductors for the utility and performs the scope of work that he did for his apprenticeship. He feels that even if the voltage is under 600 volts, it's still part of the pole and line scope of work. Mr. Partika does not feel that he should be required to obtain a C-13 license when it is not related to his pole and line work. Chairperson Isemoto stated that the C-62 and C-63 are for specialized work that is not necessarily related to primary electrical work.

Mr. Partika inquired if he could apply for a C-13 license with restrictions that would not allow him to work inside of homes and businesses. Chairperson Isemoto stated no.

Recommendation: Installing underground duct lines, handholes and/or conductors from utility poles, transformers, or other handholes within the utility area (roadway/sidewalk) and/or to a residence's meter location, is not covered under the scope of a C-62 Pole and line contractor; this work requires a C-13 Electrical contractor's license.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Teves, seconded by Mr. Arita, and unanimously carried to approve the above scope recommendation.

Chapter 91, HRS,
Adjudicatory
Matters:

Chairperson Isemoto called for a recess from the Board's meeting at 9:43 a.m. to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91.

1. Settlement Agreements

- a. In the Matter of the Contractors License of Dennis G. Young, doing business as Young Electrical Service; CLB 2019-443-L

RICO received a complaint alleging that Dennis G. Young, doing business as Young Electrical Service (“Respondent”), failed to complete an electrical wiring of a new residence and refused to call for the final inspection.

Respondent alleges that there was a two-year lapse of time from the rough-in inspection until Respondent was called back to the project and that changes in the building plans required Respondent to run new or extended wiring and there were additional problems caused by the homeowner.

RICO alleges that Respondent failed to include all required information in a written homeowner contract and failed to have at least half of the individuals performing “electrical work” at the project licensed in accordance with Hawaii Revised Statutes (“HRS”) Chapter 448E.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statutes and rule: HRS sections 444-9.5 (at least half of all individuals performing electrical work at a project must be a HRS 448E licensee) and 444-25.5 (written contract required and particular information required) and HAR 16-77-80 (information required in written contracts).

Respondent agrees to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$5,000.00.

- b. In the Matter of the Contractors’ Licenses of TLC Builder Ltd. and Thomas C. Lefler; CLB 2020-380-L

In or about August 2019, TLC Builder Ltd. and Thomas C. Lefler (“Respondents”) entered into a contract with homeowners for the construction of a new home to be located in the State of Hawaii, but did not provide the homeowners with required verbal or written disclosures regarding lien or bonding rights.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statute and rule: HRS section 444-25.5 (requiring verbal and written disclosures of lien and bonding rights to homeowners, notwithstanding owner-builder status); and HAR 16-77-80 (requiring disclosures in written contracts with homeowners).

Respondents agree to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$2,500.00.

- c. In the Matter of the Contractor Licenses of Rodney C. Hoeme and R Hoeme Construction, LLC; CLB 2020-227-L

RICO received information that on or about January 2018, Rodney C. Hoeme and R Hoeme Construction, LLC (“Respondents”) subcontracted with and paid an unlicensed person, Dennis L. Claussen, doing business as Claussen Painting, Inc., to perform the exterior painting of a house-building project in the State of Hawaii. RICO alleges that Respondents aided or abetted an unlicensed person

to evade HRS Chapter 444, in potential violation of HRS 444-9.3 (aiding or abetting an unlicensed person to evade HRS Chapter 444). Respondents allege they were not aware that the subcontractor was no longer licensed.

Respondents agree to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$5,000.00.

After discussion it was moved by Mr. Leong, seconded by Mr. Higashihara, and unanimously carried, to approve the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action in the above cases.

Following the Board's review, deliberation and decisions in these matters, pursuant to HRS chapter 91, Chairperson Isemoto announced that the Board was reconvening to its open meeting at 9:50 a.m.
