Agenda: The agenda for this meeting was posted on the State electronic calendar as required by HRS section 92-7(b).

Call to Order: There being a quorum present, Chairperson Arita called the meeting to order at 9:14 a.m.

Minutes: It was moved by Mr. Nishek, seconded by Mr. Torigoe, and unanimously carried to approve the Applications Committee Meeting Minutes of September 6, 2022, and the Board Meeting Minutes of August 18, 2022, as circulated.

Committee Reports:

1. Scope of Activity Committee:
Paul Alejado, Chairperson
 - a. Shermco Industries

Requests a determination on whether a contractor's license is required to perform specialty maintenance and repair on 1000 kW or larger wind turbines.

The repair work performed on the wind turbines includes electrical and mechanical maintenance, testing, adjustments, and repairs on the wind turbines. The components within the turbine package that are serviced by Shermco include but are not limited to the generator, gearbox, bi-directional converter, control systems (electrical and hydraulic), cabling systems throughout the turbine package, wind turbine blade repairs or replacements, and more which are too numerous to list. A variety of electrical and mechanical tests are performed on the components within the turbine package based on manufacturer or industry standard recommended practices. The specialty maintenance and repair services on the wind turbines does not include any construction activities, nor engineering or design activities.

Members reviewed information provided by Shermco Industries.

Mr. Polischek stated that performing specialty maintenance and repair on a wind turbine is a broad scope of work. If the maintenance work was limited to greasing, torquing, and routine maintenance work, a license would not be required. Mr. O'Donnell agreed and stated that the work includes "wind turbine blade repairs or replacements, etc." Although Shermco Industries stated, "The specialty maintenance and repair services on the wind turbines does not include any construction activities, nor engineering or design activities", the rigging to remove and replace the turbine blades requires cranes which could be considered as construction.

Mr. Polischek stated that it is no different than a building changing its cooling power which requires a license. The Board also discussed amending the description of the C-68WP Wind power systems contractor classification because it limits the work to systems up to 100KW.

It was moved by Mr. Alejado, seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, and unanimously carried to amend the C-68WP description as follows:

"C-68 Wind power systems contractor. To place, install and erect poles, rotors, turbines, blades and related apparatus, including footing, anchors and guys, for the purpose of wind driven power generation; provided that this shall not include raceways, grounding, wiring and power terminations. Limited to the assembly of factory manufactured systems [up to 100 KW,] and shall not include welding, structural steel or reinforcing steel work."

Recommendation: Based solely on the information provided, the "A" General engineering or the C-68WP Wind power systems contractor's license (as amended) is required to perform specialty maintenance and repair on 1,000 kW or larger wind turbines.

It was moved by Mr. Alejado, seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, and unanimously carried to approve the above scope recommendation.

b. VFC Group, LLC

Requests a determination on whether a contractor's license is required to install lightning protection systems. If a contractor's license is required, the establishment of a C-68 classification for the installation of lightning protection systems is requested.

VFC Group, LLC's ("VFC") installations are completely passive systems and are inspected by Underwriter Laboratories to ensure compliance with either UL96a or NFPA 780 (the national standards for lightning protection systems). Their typical project is a larger commercial, industrial, infrastructure or military installation. Specifications and drawings were submitted for the: (1) P-033 Magazines for Long Ordnance, West Loch, JBPHH, Oahu, Hawaii project; and (2) Victoria Place, Honolulu, Hawaii project.

Members reviewed information provided by VFC Group, LLC.

Mr. Takahashi, Hawaii Electricians Market Enhancement Program ("HEMEP") stated that he spoke with contractors from the Electrical Contractors Association of Hawaii and some electrical contractors. He went on to say that they discussed that the Contractors License Board and the Board of Electricians and Plumbers often concluded that when a scope of work included grounding and bonding and the installation of electrical conductors a C-13 is required. He stated that a lightning protection system is an electrical conductor system; it takes energy from the lightning, distributes it through a conductor system and grounds it. The entire apparatus needs to be properly grounded and bonded. Failure to ground and bond properly is a safety risk and a fire hazard.

Mr. Takahashi stated that he found that the County of Hawaii required a permit for a lightning protection system; its Permitting Department required a C-13 Electrical contractor to pull the permit and the electrical divisions did the inspections. He also found some public works projects at Hilo Airport and Kona Airport for Lightning Protection Systems where the Department of Transportation required the bidders to have a C-13 Electrical contractors license. He stated the HEMEP's position is that a C-13 license is required to install lightning protection systems. HEMEP does not have a position on the creation of a C-68 other than if it were going to be created specifically for this limited scope of work, that a C-13 would also be able to perform this work.

Chairperson Arita asked Mr. Takahashi if there will be more work coming up and more people performing this type of work as far as buildings requiring lightning protection systems. Mr. Takahashi stated that it's new to him and his understanding is that lightning has not been a major problem in Hawaii. As buildings move towards connecting to the network he can see why people would be more interested in these protection systems. These systems also add surge arresters which is an electrical apparatus.

Mr. Polischek stated that ground grids are nothing new and all powerplants and equipment substations have ground grids. Usually permits are not pulled separately because when you build a power plant or substation, it's in the design. This is a different type of lightning protection system and installation is different from a power plant, but any grounding and bonding requires a C-13 license.

Recommendation: Based solely on the information provided, the C-13 Electrical contractor license is required for the installation of lightning protection systems, including for the: (1) P-033 Magazines for Long Ordnance, West Loch, JBPHH, Oahu, Hawaii project; and (2) Victoria Place, Honolulu, Hawaii project.

It was moved by Mr. Alejado, seconded by Mr. Polischek, and unanimously carried to approve the above scope recommendation.

Chapter 91, HRS,
Adjudicatory
Matters:

Chairperson Arita called for a recess from the Board's meeting at 9:29 a.m. to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91.

1. Settlement Agreements

a. In the Matter of the Contractor's License of Railing Systems Hawaii, LLC; CLB 2021-309-L

From January of 2018 to June of 2018, Railing Systems Hawaii, LLC ("Respondent RS") engaged in structural steel work at a new dwelling located in Kailua-Kona in exchange for \$87,000.00 pursuant to the terms set forth in a written contract.

During the time of the project, Respondent RS did not possess a C-48 specialty classification license.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute a violation of Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") section 16-77-33(c) (engaging in work beyond the scope of license).

Respondent agrees to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$2,500.00.

b. In the Matter of the Contractors' Licenses of Pauliasi Takai doing business as Takai Masonry Contractor; CLB 2022-51-L

On or about August 1, 2021, Pauliasi Takai doing business as Takai Masonry Contractor ("Respondent") entered into a verbal agreement with homeowners to repair the top tier of an existing rock wall at their residence in Aiea, Hawaii in exchange for \$65,000.00.

The homeowners paid the Respondent \$65,000.00.

Respondent did not provide a written contract. Moreover, Respondent failed to provide the homeowners with any verbal or written bond and lien disclosures.

If proven at an administrative hearing, the allegations would constitute violations of the following statutes and rules: Hawaii Revised Statutes (“HRS”) section 444-25.5(b) and HAR section 16-77-80(a) (failure to provide written contract), HRS section 444-25.5(b)(1) and HAR sections 16-77-80(a)(3), 16-77-80(a)(7) and 16-77-71(a)(2) (failure to include required contract disclosures).

Respondent agrees to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$4,000.00.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Polischeck, seconded by Mr. O’Donnell, and unanimously carried to approve the Settlement Agreement Prior to Filing of Petition for Disciplinary Action in each of the above cases.

Following the Board’s review, deliberation, and decisions in these matters pursuant to HRS chapter 91, Chairperson Arita announced that the Board was reconvening to its open meeting at 9:34 a.m.

At 9:35 a.m., it was moved by Mr. Alejado, seconded by Mr. Polischeck, and unanimously carried to enter into executive session pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(1) to consider and evaluate personal information relating to individuals applying for professional or vocational licenses cited in HRS section 26-9, and to consult with Christopher Leong, Deputy Attorney General, on questions and issues pertaining to the Board’s powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities pursuant to HRS section 92-5(a)(4).

At 1:28 p.m., it was moved by Mr. Higashihara, seconded by Mr. Nishek, and unanimously carried to move out of executive session and to reconvene to the Board’s regular order of business.
