Call to Order: There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 1:06 p.m. by Chairperson McKay.

Minutes of the July 17, 2017 Board Meeting: After discussion, it was moved by Chairperson McKay, seconded by Ms. Williams, and unanimously carried to approve the minutes of the July 17, 2017 Board meeting, as circulated.

At 1:07 p.m., the Board recessed the meeting to discuss and deliberate on the following adjudicatory matter pursuant to HRS chapter 91.

After discussion, it was moved by Ms. Williams, seconded by Mr. Choi, and unanimously carried to approve the Settlement Agreement relating to the Matter of the Beauty Operator's License of Molly M. Jaedtke; BAR 2016-13-L.

The beauty shop applications above were preliminarily reviewed by licensing branch staff, the Executive Officer, Chairperson McKay, and Ms. Williams (the Board members designated to review the barber shop and beauty shop applications for consideration at this Board meeting).

Chairperson McKay stated that she and Ms. Williams reviewed the twenty-eight (28) applications, and concluded that they met all requirements for barber shop and beauty shop licenses, and recommends approval.

After discussion, it was moved by Chairperson McKay, seconded by Mr. Choi, and unanimously carried to approve the twenty-eight (28) barber shop and beauty shop applications listed above.

Educational
Sessions Held

And Barbers:

Executive Officer Kai requested to table this matter as DAG Wong had been excused from this meeting. She reminded the Board that it had requested DAG Wong to conduct further research on whether HRS section 439-2 (b) and Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") sections 16-78-36(6) and 16-78-37(5), or any other statutes or administrative rules were pertinent to the matter under consideration by the Board. It was reiterated that the issue had been initiated by occurrences in the professional community where licensed beauty operators without Hawaii instructor licenses are conducting educational sessions held in licensed shops for and are designed and offered to already licensed beauty operators and barbers who are charged a fee for the instructional session(s).

After discussion, it was moved by Chairperson McKay, seconded by Mr. Choi, and unanimously carried to table this agenda item and defer decision-making on the matter to the next Board meeting in order to provide DAG Wong time to conduct further research into the matter.

Proposal by

Executive Officer Kai stated that the Board received a request for the review of a proposal by Sojazzie Enterprises LLC ("Sojazzie") to open a "salon suite"; a concept that will offer cosmetologists, barbers, massage therapists, estheticians, and fashion photographers the opportunity to lease or rent separate salon suites to service their clients in the privacy of their own facilities. The proposal described how Sojazzie would provide upscale facilities with the latest in modern amenities to be shared in common areas within the facility. Sojazzie would also provide business support services for new owners, including assistance with professional and business licenses, marketing, merchant services, tax planning, and insurance referrals.

Discussion ensued on the barber and beauty shop requirements for the facility described in the proposal. The Board directed the Executive Officer to notify Sojazzie of the barber shop and beauty shop requirements that its "salon suite" facility would need to meet in order to be licensed, and to further apprise Sojazzie that the renters (as independent contractors) of the separate suites would need their own barber shop or beauty shop licenses.

Legislation and
Rules:

A. Senate Bill No. 947, Senate Draft 2, House Draft 1, Conference Draft 1, relating to Citations for Beauty Culture Violations

Executive Officer Kai reported that Senate Bill No. 947, Senate Draft 2, House Draft 1, Conference Draft 1, relating to Citations for Beauty Culture Violations, was signed into law as Act 148, by Governor David Ige on July 10, 2017.

B. Senate Bill No. 1286, Senate Draft 2, House Draft 2, Conference Draft 1, relating to Private Trade, Vocational, and Technical Schools

Executive Officer Kai reported that Senate Bill No. 1286, Senate Draft 2, House Draft 2, Conference Draft 1, relating to Private Trade, Vocational, and Technical Schools, was signed into law as Act 164, by Governor David Ige on

July 11, 2017. She reiterated that this Act clarifies the scope of the private trade, vocational, and technical school licensure program within the Department of Education ("DOE"), and noted that beauty schools are exempted from the statute because they are authorized and licensed by this Board and the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs to provide beauty culture instruction to the public. This Act also establishes a \$2000 licensing fee to ensure the sustainability of the licensure program, as well as establishing a license renewal process and \$2000 renewal fee. It also created the private trade, vocational, and technical school licensure special fund and appropriated moneys (\$100,000 per year) for one full-time equivalent position with the DOE to administer licensing.

Discussion ensued on the Board's attempt to update the Hawaii Administrative Rules, Chapter 16-73 (Barbering) and Chapter 16-78 (Cosmetology). Board members were advised to decide what areas were of most concern to them to address now as amendments to the HAR chapters.
